Volunteer Committee Descriptions



Volunteers are needed primarily in the morning each day. Some committees begin their work as early as 6 a.m. Most end by the mid-afternoon. Volunteers are asked to be present for at least five-to-six hours **on two days** as noted for each committee.

Walking Assistants

One Walking Assistant will accompany each group of three golfers. Each golfer may have a caddie and or/an aide. The Walking Assistant will provide additional help as needed with mobility issues, tee & spot balls, rake traps, guide spectators and provide other assistance as needed. It is essential to be in good physical condition with the ability to walk 18 holes at a pace to keep pace with players.

TIME: 14 arrive at 8 a.m.; 14 arrive at 9:30 a.m. on Saturday
14 arrive at 7 a.m.; 14 arrive at 8:30 a.m. on Sunday
SHIFT: 6 hours (approximately)

Walking Scorers

One Walking Scorer will accompany each group of three golfers, using his/her personal cell phone to record scores for each hole, and also record the scores on a printed scorecard. It is essential to be in good physical condition with the ability to walk 18 holes and keep pace with the players.

NUMBER: 28 on Saturday, 28 on Sunday (none on Friday)
TIME: 14 arrive at 8 a.m.; 14 arrive at 9:30 a.m. on Saturday
14 arrive at 7 a.m.; 14 arrive at 8:30 a.m. on Sunday
SHIFT: 6 hours (approximately)

Practice Range & Green

Volunteers will monitor the practice range and putting green, admitting and assisting players (as needed), caddies and aides while keeping spectators and others at a safe distance. The members of this committee will make sure the area has plenty of golf balls.

NUMBER: 7 on Friday & Saturday; 4 on Sunday
4 arrive when range opens;
3 arrive at 11 a.m. Friday & Saturday only
RANGE OPEN: 6 a.m. – 3 p.m. Friday;
7:30 a.m. – 3 :30 p.m. Saturday;
6:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. Sunday
SHIFT: 5-6 hours

Shuttles / Parking

Direct drivers to the designated parking areas for competitors, volunteers and staff. Using six-person shuttle carts, transport players, caddies and aides (and possibly family and friends) from parking lot to registration area, practice range/putting green, first and tenth tees. Direct and assist spectators who arrive by shuttle bus from remote parking area. Repeat the process in reverse when the round is completed.

NUMBER: 7 each day, less needed if volunteer works both shifts

TIME: Friday and Sunday: 4 arrive at 6 a.m.; 3 arrive at 11 a.m.

Saturday: 4 arrive at 6:30 a.m.; 3 arrive at 11 a.m.

SHIFT: 5-6 hours

**Golf Cart Services /
Product Delivery**

Volunteers will work with the Fox Bend staff to arrange carts for players, caddies, aides and officials in designated staging areas. In addition to standard two-person golf carts, there are special single-seat and adaptive golf carts that will be assigned to some players.

Work with Fox Bend staff to bring beverages, ice, and snacks to designated areas on the course, practice range and the Tournament Headquarters Pavilion Tent. This committee requires heavy lifting.

NUMBER: 6 each day, less needed if volunteer works both shifts

TIME: 3 arrive at 6 a.m.; 3 arrive at 11 a.m.

SHIFT: 5-6 hours

**Player Registration /
Pro-Am Registration /
Caddie Services**

Volunteers will register and welcome players, caddies, aides and greet spectators each day. On Friday, they will register participants in the pro-am. Volunteers will be familiar with general tournament information and course layout to answer questions. Volunteers are responsible for the Caddie Bib collection and redistribution.

NUMBER: 8 each day, less needed if volunteer works both shifts

TIME: Friday and Sunday: 5 arrive at 6 a.m.; 3 arrive at 11 a.m.

Saturday: 5 arrive at 6:30 a.m.; 3 arrive at 11 a.m.

SHIFT: 5 hours

**Volunteer Hospitality /
Headquarters Pavilion Tent**

Volunteers will be in charge of hospitality at the Tournament Headquarters Pavilion Tent. Duties include checking-in volunteers, answering questions, distributing volunteer uniforms, assisting meal vendors, and keeping the venue clean.

NUMBER: 8 each day, less needed if volunteer works both shifts

TIME: Friday and Sunday: 5 arrive at 6 a.m.; 3 arrive at 11 a.m.

Saturday: 5 arrive at 6:30 a.m.; 3 arrive at 11 a.m.

SHIFT: 5 hours
