The Rules of Golf qualification requirements that are set for the CDGA championships and qualifiers DO NOT apply to the Social Event Competitions. All Blue Coats are welcome to volunteer at any of the below events. To make the day run smoothly it is imperative that we have Blue Coat involvement at all CDGA Social Competitions. Assignments for Social Competitions are completed each month and sent in the monthly Blue Coat email.

CDGA Women's Trifecta (4 Event Days)
CDGA / VGA 2-Person Veteran's Cup Series (5 Event Days)
\*CDGA Member Days (4 Event Days)

- The role of a Blue Coat at a CDGA Social Event may include Registration Assistance/Pace of Play Rover/Scoring Assistance/and other assignments as deemed necessary the day of the event.
  - \*CDGA Member Days do not require Blue Coat assistance they are not on the sign-up page
- We strive for a minimum of 2 volunteers and a maximum of 4 at each event.
- If a Rules of Golf situation arises all rulings will need to be called in on the "radio" to the staff person in charge of the event.
- To be considered for an assignment for popular locations you will have had to submit your availability prior to receiving the monthly Blue Coat email.
- Every effort will be given to make sure a volunteer who is given "No Assignment" for one event will be given an assignment for another.
